## FROM THE DIRECTOR

One of our goals is to reduce the number of abortions in our area. Rock County's vital statistics show that 163 women in our area reported they chose abortion the year Stateline Pregnancy Clinic began using ultrasound. In 2011 the number of reported abortions in our county was more than half that! That's a good report! Our organization is 27 years old, so you understand why I am amazed when I hear people say they have never heard of us. That is why we need to get aggressive in making ourselves known in our community through outdoor/billboard advertising. By earmarking your giving to our "Billboard Fund" you can help inform others of our valuable services.

Funny how everyone knows America's leading abortion chain by name. By the way, they did 332,378 abortions last year. That is a decrease making it their worst year ever! As good as that is to know, to my way of thinking one abortion is still one too many.

The Bible warns those who would call good "evil" and evil "good." In a culture saturated with conflicting ideals, speaking the truth in love is imperative. When the Rockford abortion mill closed because of health code violations, we began to see a marked increase in abortion minded client calls and visits. "Praise God!" the first two weeks of this year began with three abortion minded clients choosing LIFE! Make no mistake, each of these women had difficulty as they tussled with their options, struggling with

pressure from their loved ones and their own fears. But, God is faithful to save . . . And HE did!

As this ministry jumps with both feet into 2012 I realize how much we accomplished last year because of your prayers and gifts. Amazed as I am at God's faithfulness in 2011, we are compelled to look forward through the eyes of faith. We truly have plans too big for human hands! For example, we have an initiative for a new Ultrasound machine. It is time to update our current one which is now over 10 years old. Images on newer machines are clearer plus they have the ability to hear a baby's heartbeat. For the abortion-bent client whose pregnancy is less than 6 weeks, and more likely to seek out the abortion pill alternative, hearing that heartbeat is another way to bond mom and baby. It's a lifesaving tool. Effective results happen when we are equipped effectively. You can help us build this initiative with a gift.
